GENERAL PARADE INFORMATION

Weather Conditions:

Remember that Plymouth is on the water: you should be prepared for variable weather conditions.

Muster Time:

1. You must start arriving at your muster area at 8:30 am on the morning of the parade.
2. You must have everyone in place by 10:30 sharp. We will move as many divisions as possible onto Court Street at 10:45 am
3. This means all vehicles must be removed by 9:30am. No exceptions! Any vehicle in the Muster area after 9:30 will not be able to leave the area, due to safety issues.
4. When dropping off participants, access the mustering area by using the North side of Court Street.

Muster Area Rules:

1. Each group will be assigned to a **Division**.
2. In that division, you will be assigned to a **Division Leader** who will be wearing an **Orange Safety Vest**.
3. The Person in charge of your group must report to the Information/Check-in Booth at the Muster Field as soon as you arrive to be informed of any last minute changes.
4. You will also be assigned a specific line up number for your group. This number corresponds to a cone that will be placed on the street you are assigned at that time.
5. Position assigned in Parade Line Up may not be changed.
6. *We ask that you collect all trash and belongings; the muster areas are in front of neighbor's homes. Please be respectful and stay off lawns/property.*
7. Portable rest rooms will be located around the muster areas for your use.
8. You will also be able to purchase coffee and hot chocolate at a local fundraiser stand at the Muster Field.

Parade Rules:

1. Candy may not be distributed at anytime during the parade.
2. No recording or live broadcasting of political or commercial messages is allowed.
3. No distribution of leaflets, brochures, etc. of any kind is allowed.
4. If anything is determined to be inappropriate for the Parade Theme it will be removed from the parade
5. We ask that no cars be left in front of homes or on the parade route. There is parking at the end of the parade route.
6. As with all parades in Plymouth, the police will ticket and tow cars left on the parade route.
7. Remember, this is a moving parade. **Please...no stopping.**
8. **Please maintain 25 feet or less between your unit, and the unit in front of you.**
9. Please avoid loud noise or the firing of guns if positioned near horses.
10. Last, but not least...have FUN!
